The Johari Window contains four quadrants labelled (in clockwise order): Open Self, Blind Self, Unknown Self, and Private Self. The x-axis of the Johari Window represents information about the self either known to the self or not known to the self. The y-axis of the Johari Window represents information about the self that is either known to others or not known to others. The Open Self is the quadrant that represents information about the self that is both known to the self and to others. The Blind Self is the quadrant that represents information about the self that is not known to the self, but is known to others. The Unknown Self is the quadrant that represents information about the self that is neither known to the self nor to others. The Private Self is the quadrant that represents information about the self that is known to the self, but not known to others.
